From the Pastor

The parishioners extend our condolences to Ray and Joyce Vahling and their family as they deal with the loss of Ray's sister, Sister Helen Vahling, O.S.F. Her funeral was at St. John's Church in Joliet this past Thursday. Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord. I met Sister for the first time when I was in 5th grade at St. John's School, and she was the teacher for the other 5th grade. She was stationed here in the 1980's and worked with the Religious Education program. May God give her the reward of her labors.

The feast of the Assumption of Mary is August 15th. This is a holy day of obligation. Please mark your calendar and count on coming to one of our 3 Masses that day. There is Mass at 6:00 a.m.; 12:10; and the third Mass is in the evening at 7:00 o'clock. I am always impressed with the large number of people, who attend Mass on the holy days. I realize that some of the people are from other parishes, but it is good to see people coming together to pray and worship the Lord.

For those in the practice of coming to Mass during the week, you will want to mark your calendar because we are going to have a change with the Mass for the children. It used to be we offered an 8 o'clock Mass on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. There was a 6:30 Mass every day of the week. On Monday and Wednesday there was only the 6:30 Mass. Beginning the week of August 13th, we will have the usual 6:30 Mass each morning, and an 8:00 Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. The Masses with children will have 3rd and 4th grades on Tuesday; 1st and 2nd on Wednesday and 5th and 6th grades on Friday. This should work out very well. We also have Mass at Evergreen Nursing Home on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays, and we often have a 12:10 Mass for the 55+ group on the 3rd Thursday. Thank God for calendars!

While you are marking your calendar, please note that the 10:30 Mass on the 20th of this month is going to highlight our children, who are being confirmed and receiving their first Communion on Saturday morning, the 19th of August, at the cathedral. We will likely need the space in our church for the children and their families on that Sunday at the 10:30 Mass. If you usually attend this Mass on the weekend, please make plans to come to Mass at a different time. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. We have 46 third graders who are going to be fully initiated on the 19th at the cathedral. Please keep our children and their families in your prayers.

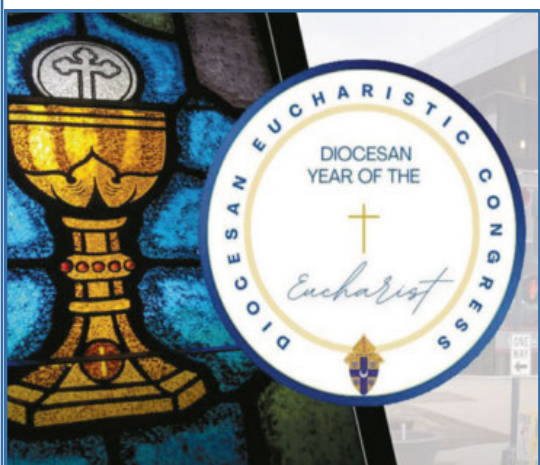
