From the Pastor

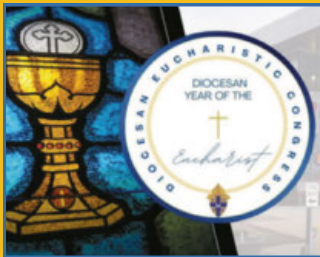
