

From the Pastor

Our parish had a "first" Saturday when over 40 of our third graders and their families and friends made the trip to the cathedral to receive the sacrament of Confirmation and then they received their first Holy Communion. I am more accustomed to the children receiving their first Communion in the parish church, so this put the experience into a larger context of "church" with the cathedral and the bishop. I think it all went well.

The children, their parents and I am very grateful to the students' catechists, who have shared their faith with the third graders. And we are all grateful to Dan and Susie Niemerg and Camille Neihls for all the work they put into the program. And everyone would have been hungry after the 10:30 Mass if it weren't for Rita Habing, who got all the refreshments that were enjoyed. Thank you to all for making this a wonderful and memorable day in the lives of our children.

Thank you to those of you who have already responded to our census project. This is the year of the census in our parish. We need to know who lives here and who considers themselves members of the parish. If you haven't filled out one of the forms yet, please do so. Thanks.

We are merely days away from our parish picnic, which is on September 16th. One of the reasons for moving the picnic to Saturday vice Sunday is the hope that people will remain at the picnic in the evening instead of going home and preparing for work the next day. The move to Saturday seems to have been successful last year. And we are having the golf ball drop again – and like last year it will be from a helicopter!! Be sure to give the golf ball a try or two or three!!

We need more names for parishioners going to the diocesan celebration of the Eucharist in Springfield on October 28th. The last time we did a parish census was 10 years ago! We need the cooperation of everyone. Thank you.




Religious Education News
