From the Pastor

This Monday is Labor Day. We will have Mass at 9:00 a.m. We usually have Mass at 6:30 on Monday mornings, but with the holiday changing to a later time allows more freedom in the morning. This is the only Mass we will have on Monday.

The plan calls for me to report to St. Mary's Hospital in Decatur on Wednesday, September 6th, at 5:30 a.m. Some time during the day I will have surgery that should last 90 minutes. The doctor tells me I'll be in the hospital for 3 days. Some parishioners have had this surgery to remove the arthritis or stenosis from between their vertebrae, and this is usually a procedure that does not require hospitalization. For me, in addition to cleaning out what's between the vertebrae, the doctor is also going to fuse a couple of the vertebrae.

My restrictions are not to leave the house for 2 weeks and don't lift anything more than 5 pounds for those days. After that, I can lift 15 pounds, and this is for 5 weeks. After these nearly two months I will be free of all restrictions.

All the friars are going to the first chapter of our new province in Kansas City in October, from the 16th to the 20. I didn't intend to attend this, figuring I'd stay home and have a 6:30 Mass and be available for any funerals. And I will not be going to the convocation with the priests in the diocese like I have done for the last several years. Pastors MUST be there for the Tuesday session. Convocation is Monday to Thursday. I did intend to go to this, but I cancelled out of it. I'm sure our bishop and I will have a conversation.

Some of you have seen me walking in town, and I don't know if you have seen me sitting on Zack and Jennie Mette's front steps or Gene Runde's lawn chairs by his garage because I couldn't make it another block! The nerve to that leg is connected to the vertebrae in my back, and my prayer is this surgery will solve the problem of pain in my leg from walking or even from standing a long time in one place.

I appreciate the friars stepping up to the plate as they would expect me to do for them. And I am grateful for any prayers you can offer for my successful surgery and recovery. Tough part is going to be the initial two weeks, I think!

Sunday, September 10th, is our Catechetical Sunday. At all the weekend Masses we will give our catechists a gift. We don't say thank you often enough, but I hope the large number of people engaged in our religious education ministry – in the classroom or out of the classroom – are aware that the parish is grateful for their sacrifice and all they do for our children to grow in their faith.

And then we have September 16th: Our Parish Picnic. We will have Mass outside in the mini-park at 4:00 in the afternoon. Everyone is invited. What a beautiful way to kick-off our picnic: we praise God and thank the Lord for the many blessings we enjoy as a parish, a faithful and faith-filled community. The altar is not going to be where it was last year. This affords the opportunity for more people to be in the shade. Get your tickets for the golf ball drop. Only 500 tickets are being sold.

PARISH CENSUS—You should have received in the mail my letter and information on the parish census. Please fill out the census *as soon as you can, preferably electronically*. If you need to fill out the information manually, that's fine.

Parish volunteers will be calling on people we do NOT hear from.

The last time we did a parish census was 10 years ago! We need the cooperation of everyone. Thank you.

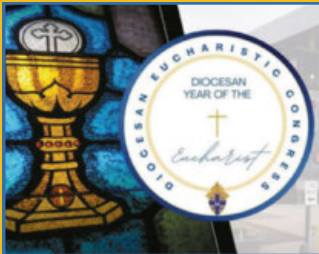
