ASSISI FOR AFRICA – News from Fr. Damien: "Blessings on all. I simply have not had time to write and also my computer was not working for I had not paid the tax. But the most important thing was my running back and forth to two hospitals for our sick boys ... our boy, 14 yrs old, who woke up one morning and could hardly get out of bed for his body was bloated with water and he was three times bigger. For six months we have been fighting against this rare sickness ... Another boy, who is 15 years old, is taking care of our sick boy...every day and he has been a gift from God."
