

From the Pastor

This Sunday we have the blessing of the animals at 1 o'clock in front of the grotto that is north of the grade school. We will begin promptly in case people want to participate in the Life Chain. There is a service at 1:30 in Sacred Heart Church in Effingham. This is followed by a Life Chain on Keller Drive from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. Signs will be furnished, and there will be refreshments afterwards.

The feast of the patron of our parish, St. Francis of Assisi, is on October 4th. Traditionally we have a prayer service called the Transitus on the evening before the feast since the Transitus commemorates the passing over of St. Francis from this life to eternal life. We will gather in church at 6:00 pm. Following the prayer service everyone is invited into the friary for visiting and refreshments. There will NOT be confessions at 6:15 on October the 3rd. We normally have confessions from 6:15 to 6:45 on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

Mark your calendar for October 9th and October 23rd. These are the dates designated for our parish to participate in the Prayer Campaign for Life. Come to the church for an hour on each of these two dates to pray for a Respect for Life.

I thank the many parishioners, who have taken the time to send me a get well card, and I especially thank those of you, who have been praying for me, for the success of the surgery, which was on Sept 6th, and for complete recovery. I met with the surgeon on Sept 21st, and he said that I was "ahead of schedule" in terms of healing and recovery. I don't go back to see him for 6 weeks. Still have to avoid bending, twisting, lifting (any thing more than 15 pounds). He said I should do "relaxed walking." I never heard of that since I usually try to increase my mileage on a walk. Thank you again for your prayers, and I very much appreciate your keeping me on your prayer list. Your prayers are working.

I have been stationed at: Sacred Heart Friary in Indianapolis, IN working at St. Patrick's, Quincy, IL working as a Chaplain at the University, Chicago. IL working at St. Peter's in the loop as confessor and supply ministry. I am SO happy and excited to be at T-Town, the cradle of our Province.

May the Lord give me the energy and health to do all that I would love to do here, at Sacred Heart in Effingham and wherever the Lord needs me.


