

We are told there were 100 people responding with their training and gear, and they all survived! We thank the Lord, and we are grateful to the angels who protected them.

I'm sure the people involved with fighting fires know the answer, but how many times would you guess our volunteer fire department has been called out – at all hours of the day and night – to put out a fire resulting from a crash of a truck along I-70. The community is grateful for the sacrifices made by our fire fighters and the members of their families who pray for them and wait for them to come home safely. I tend to think locally, our Teutopolis Fire Department, but the recent events demonstrate how others come to help and support a local cause. We help them when their community experiences a need, and they help us when we experience a crisis.

God bless our First Responders and their families.

This past Wednesday was the feast of the patron of our parish: St. Francis of Assisi. He is a saint, who is loved by many all over the world. It would be interesting to learn how many statues there are of St. Francis in people's homes and yards and gardens. He loved nature because it was a manifestation of the beauty of God. On October 22, as we observe World Mission Sunday, we stand in solidarity with the Missions of the Church in this annual worldwide Eucharistic celebration.




