

We are now a new province of Franciscans! Instead of the Sacred Heart Province, with headquarters in St. Louis, six provinces consolidated this week in Kansas City, MO, to become one province, and our name is the Province of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our headquarters are in Atlanta, Georgia. I will hear about the events from the friars when they return home from Kansas City. You have heard the expression, the more things change, the more they stay the same. I don't anticipate big changes for us, but our God is a God of surprises, and our God has a tremendous sense of humor. Stay tuned, and when I hear something, I will pass it on to you.

This Sunday at our 10:30 Mass we are recognizing the Firefighters from the Teutopolis and Montrose Fire Departments. The parishioners, and the community in general, are grateful to our firefighters and their families for all they do during the year and especially their heroic efforts recently with the tanker accident. For more information, please go to: <u>WWW.DIO.ORG/REVIVAL-BOS/</u> We have been informing you about this in the bulletin for months, and our diocesan newspaper "Catholic Times" has been giving us information about the Congress taking place in Springfield on Saturday, October 28<sup>th</sup>.

Please note that there will NOT be any Masses in the diocese at any parish on Saturday, Oct 28<sup>th</sup>. Nor will there be any confessions. Our bishop wants maximum participation with our Eucharistic Congress. There will be excellent speakers and booths with information. Doors open at 10:30 a.m., and Mass is at 4:00 p.m.

At our last parish council meeting I asked what we can do about visitations before funerals in the parish. Because of the volume of noise and disrespect for the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle, I was suggesting that we have visitations in the funeral homes – with Bauer's being in the Effingham funeral home vice the one in Teutopolis. This is not a new discussion. Some suggested we put up signs on the church pillars reminding people to keep the noise down low. Another suggestion that has come from the liturgy committee is to remove the Blessed Sacrament from the tabernacle during visitation. The church will be like it is on Good Friday and Holy Saturday – empty of the Blessed Sacrament. If people have complete disregard for the Real Presence of the Blessed Sacrament by treating the church like it is a hall instead of a sacred space, then it's necessary to respond appropriately. Some people probably won't even notice.


