#### From the Pastor

Please note that we have only one Mass on Thanksgiving morning this year, and the time of that Mass is at 9:00 a.m. Is there a better way for a family to celebrate Thanksgiving than for them to come together and give praise to our Father, Son and Holy Spirit? I think a grateful heart is a joyful heart. We realize God's graciousness in our lives, and we almost automatically want to give the Lord thanks and praise and share our blessings with others.

At our 9 o'clock Mass thanksgiving morning we will not take up a collection of canned goods. There will be a collection or offering gathered. The total collection will go to our local Catholic Charities, and they can certainly use whatever we can give them. This is certainly part of our stewardship and sharing. Please be generous. Make your check out to the parish, and we will then give Catholic Charities one check from St. Francis Parish. I'm sure they have many people with needs for food, clothing, rent, utilities and many others.

On Monday, 20 November, our Parish Council is meeting. We will get a progress report on the Parish Census. Presumed numbers for the past few years will likely be changed and updated. The numbers 1,200 and 1,300 have been used to describe the number of families in our parish. A family could be only one person or perhaps 8 or 9 or more people. I thank those of you who participated in filling out the census form for our office so we can have current information. Some of our records in the office show children present, who have graduated from college and moved away! No one has called the office to update our records. It's similar for marriages. Parishioners get married here and find a place to rent in the parish, and they presume their record automatically gets updated. Please call the office when there is a change with your information.

Families have their own customs for celebrating the holiday of Thanksgiving. Maybe as part of your family prayer, or during the meal, your conversation could be about what each person is grateful for.
