From the Pastor

Today we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. We also celebrate the end of the church year. Next Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent. And this year Christmas is on a Monday, which somewhat complicates our Masses for Christmas Eve! We have our regular Sunday Masses, and then we have additional Masses for the celebration of Christmas Eve and Christmas. There will be ample opportunity for people to come to Mass for the 4th Sunday of Advent as well as Christmas Eve and Christmas morning. One of my favorite questions is: “Does this Mass count?” The question is: does this fulfill the obligation of attending Mass? We have the obligation to attend Masses for Sunday AND the holy day of Christmas. The vigil for Christmas is Christmas Eve, and if you come to the 4:00 o’clock Mass, then come early. We have 4 Masses for the Sunday obligation: 2 on Saturday evening (4:00 and 6:00) and two Masses on Sunday morning: (6:30 and 8:30).

The renovation on the steeple is finished, and most people would never know or see the difference! There were tons of bricks on the steeple supporting the four “mini-steeples” on the corners. The bricks have been removed. They have served their purpose for decades. The white tops on each corner have been power painted so they should last for a long time before they need painting. And overall we are in a much safer situation than what we had before. Thank you to Dennis and Gary Deters and their crew at DD Signs for working with the parish.

We are in the middle of our Giving Tree ministry now. And it really is a ministry or service when you think of the many people, who go shopping and then wrap presents, which are then given to people unknown to the givers. They are known to God, and their Christmas is more happy because they have received something they would like. The parish has been doing this for a couple decades, and hundreds of people have been involved – both the giver and the receiver. I join many others and simply marvel at all the presents that are in front of the Blessed Virgin altar. Makes me proud to be a member of St. Francis Parish. Thank you to the many people who will make this Christmas a little brighter for others. God bless your generosity.





PRAY THE ROSARY FOR PEACE

Our Lady said to the three shepherd children at Fatima, Portugal, on July 13, 1917, "Continue to say the Rosary every day in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary, to obtain the peace of the world and the end of the war, because only she can obtain it." World War I ended shortly after the last apparitions at Fatima. But we didn't fully respond to Mary's instructions at Fatima: praying the Rosary daily; repenting of sin and turning to God; fasting and offering other sacrifices in reparation for sin and for the conversion of poor sinners. And wars continue. Can you sacrifice 20 extra minutes by coming early before the Saturday vigil or Sunday Mass, in order to pray with fellow parishioners for peace in Israel, Ukraine, and in the whole world?
