

Plenary Indulgence: Christmas

In April, the Franciscan Family appealed to Pope Francis for him to allow plenary indulgences for people, who visit a Catholic church under the pastoral care of the Franciscans. This is part of the 800th anniversary of the Franciscans. Rome responded favorably, "so between December 8, 2023 and February 2, 2024 a person visiting a Franciscan church and praying before the Nativity scene can receive a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions. The bishops made it clear that people physically unable to visit a Franciscan church can still be eligible for a plenary indulgence. "Likewise, those who are sick or unable to participate physically can equally benefit from the gift of plenary indulgence, offering their sufferings to the Lord or carrying out practices of piety." Franciscan nativities will remain standing until the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus, February 2, rather than the Feast of the Epiphany, January 6.



OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, PATRONESS OF THE UNBORN AND OF THE AMERICAS -- In

1531, the Blessed Mother appeared to Saint Juan Diego, a poor Aztec Indian who lived near Mexico City. She instructed him to have the bishop build a church on the site. The last time she appeared to St. Juan, on December 12, she arranged roses in his tilma (or cloak) for him to bring to the bishop. When he brought the roses before the bishop, the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was miraculously present on his tilma. Made from a poor quality cactus-cloth, the tilma should have deteriorated within 20 years but shows no sign of decay after over 490 years. To this day the image defies all scientific explanations.

In 1531, the Aztec culture practiced bloodthirsty paganism with human sacrifice, especially of children. Nine million pagan Aztecs converted to Christ by the power of the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the practice of human sacrifice was abolished.

It is the only apparition where Mary is pregnant with Jesus. Like St. Juan Diego, we now live in a world in which child sacrifice is practiced -- through abortion. Let us humbly pray to our Lady for miracles of conversion to happen. Virgin of Guadalupe, Patroness of unborn children, we implore your intercession for every child at risk of abortion. ... Guide our public officials to defend each and every human life through just laws. Inspire us all to bring our faith into public life, to speak for those who have no voice. We ask this in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ, who is Love and Mercy itself. Amen." USCCB Secretariat of Pro-Life Activities, "A Prayer to Our Lady of Guadalupe"
