

From the Pastor

I suspect you find it as difficult as I do to believe that Ash Wednesday is less than 3 weeks away!! And this year Valentine's Day falls on Ash Wednesday! Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstaining. On <u>every</u> Friday in Lent we abstain from eating meat, and on Good Friday we abstain and also fast, meaning no food in between meals, and we eat only one meal. We can eat two smaller meals that cannot add up to one meal. The scrupulous person might get out a scale and weigh the food he is eating at the three different times, just to make sure that he or she wasn't eating more than allowed. That's the law. There is a spirit that is driving the law, and that spirit is one of spiritual discipline.

If we are honest with ourselves, then we have to admit that a person, who is strict about observance, is probably very legalistic. "How much can I eat before..." would be a question for the person, and legalism lends itself to a minimalism. What is the least I have to do is a concern for the strict person.

Instead of waiting for Ash Wednesday to consider a Lenten practice, why not be thinking about it now. People can give up certain foods or drinks. Some might be more interested in putting a positive spin on Lent, and they might visit relatives or friends, who are confined to a nursing home or another facility. Others might sit down and write a letter to an elderly relative they haven't seen for a long time.

We will have Stations or Way of the Cross every Friday evening during Lent. Elsewhere in this bulletin you can read about and consider another possibility for a new Lenten practice that involves your own reading, reflecting and possibly sharing with other parishioners. We need to avoid waiting until Palm Sunday to figure out some Lenten practice we would like to develop during Lent! Ideally, we could practice something that will continue after Easter.

Palms for Burning—Please bring your old palms to church from now through February 12th. Place them in the basket in front of Mary's altar. They will be burned and the ashes will be used on Ash Wednesday, February 14th.


What are you going to DO for Lent 2024?
