From the Pastor

I presume that most, if not all, of you have heard that Fr. Vernon Olmer was embraced by Sister Death. I found an obituary on the internet, and here is part of what I found. "He (Fr. He is also survived by many, many nieces and nephews and many great nieces and nephews." The article continues: "Funeral services for Fr. Vernon will be held at St. Francis Church in Humphrey, NE. Funeral services will be at the church on Friday evening, February 2, from 5 to 7 pm., with a service at 7 pm. The Mass of resurrection will be celebrated on Saturday, February 3, 2024 at 10:00 a.m at St. Francis Church in Humphrey, NE. The inurnment will be in the friars' plot in the parish cemetery in Humphrey, NE at a later date."

Both the parishioners of St. Francis in Teutopolis and the Franciscans serving at St. Francis Parish offer their condolences to the family of Fr. Vernon, who served at St. Francis parish for many years. We wish him eternal rest and peace.

Another friar stationed at Manitowoc, and one, who is dear to our parishioners is Fr. Kenneth Rosswog. Fr. Ken is a couple years older than Fr. Vernon.

Both men, Fr. Ken and Fr. Vernon, served the parish and this area of the Lord's vineyard with great dedication. We are grateful for their ministry.


What are you going to <u>DO</u> for Lent 2024?
