#### From the Pastor

The parishioners of St. Francis extend our condolences to the family of Bill Myers, who was buried from St. Francis Church Wednesday morning. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord.

I don't know how many times this coincidence has happened in the past, but this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day! As you know, with Ash Wednesday we begin the penitential season of Lent. It is a day of fast and abstinence. No meat. No eating between meals. And only one large meal such that the other two meals shouldn't add up to the one large meal. Rather than getting a scale and weighing each of the meals you eat that day, go for the spirit of fasting. You don't want to be scrupulous, but you don't want to ignore the feast for what it is either. If you are 14 years of age or older, then you must abstain. If your age is between 18 and 59, then you are obliged to fast. Years ago a couple people tried convincing me that when you turn 70 years old, you don't have to abstain any more. I don't know where it says that in canon law, but I would be interested in learning! If you are ill, then common sense takes over, and you need to eat when you can.

The three pillars for Lent are praying, fasting and almsgiving. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are two days when we have to fast and abstain. ALL FRIDAYS in Lent are days of abstinence. It's not really a penance since one can enjoy a delicious meal when it doesn't have meat in it. These are minimal expectations for a Catholic. To deliberately ignore these laws, when you are in good health, is confession material.

During Lent we have the Way of the Cross (Stations) on every Friday evening. On March 21st, Thursday, we will offer the opportunity for receiving the sacrament of Penance. 3 priests will be available for confession. We have confessions every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 6:15 to 6:45 and on Saturday afternoon from 3 to 4 o'clock. We offer 6:30 Mass every weekday morning, and coming to Mass during the week is an excellent form of prayer for Lent and any time of the year.

Beginning Saturday morning, March 2, we will start offering an 8 o'clock Mass on the first Saturday of the month. This has been requested, and we can try it. This will be something to keep in mind when we have weddings again. There aren't weddings during Lent here at St. Francis. Weddings are hardly occasions for penitence.
