

From the Pastor

This weekend we have a speaker at each of our Masses to encourage your generosity for the Catholic Charities collection. As you know, this organization helps people in many areas whether it is help with rent or utilities or food. They don't ask which parish you belong to. They are interested in meeting the needs of people presently having a difficult time. One of our three "legs" for Lent is almsgiving. The other two are fasting and prayer. Giving to our Catholic Charities collection would help to cover the need we have for giving alms. Please be generous.

We have Stations or Way of the Cross every Friday evening during Lent. This starts at 7:00 each Friday. Rarely does it last a half hour. Come and pray as we remember our Lord's passion and death. Each Friday someone, or a group, will lead us in our prayer and meditation on the suffering of Jesus.

A reminder: every Friday in Lent is a day of abstinence. People who are 14 years old, and older, refrain from eating meat. To deliberately refuse to follow this law is a serious matter. The same for Good Friday. It's a day of abstinence from meat AND it is a day of fasting: no food between meals. If you are between the ages of 18 and 59, then Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstaining. It isn't asking a whole lot from us Catholics.

Mark <u>March 21st</u> on your calendar. This is exactly a week before Holy Thursday. At seven o'clock we will be offering a time for confessions.

Each parish in the diocese is supposed to have a Capital Campaign. Prior to setting a date each parish is to conduct a Vitality Study of the parish. Members of the Vitality Study in our parish are: Sharon and Herman Brummer, Michelle Niebrugge, Derek Powell, Jackie and Steve Witges, Barb Weber and Ben Zuber. I think "Vitality Study" is an interesting term to use. How vital or how alive are we as members of St. Francis Parish? We have had only one meeting so far, and I will keep you up to date on what is happening with the work of this committee. Please keep the committee in your prayers.

Annual Catholic Charities Collection. Catholic Charities serves thousands in desperate situations throughout our diocese. This comes in the form of meeting basic needs such as food, clothing, housing and medical/dental assistance as well as providing long term services in counseling, guardianship and legal assistance. LENT BEGAN FEBRUARY 14TH

Lenten Regulations

- 1. ABSTINENCE—Everyone <u>14</u> years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST—Everyone <u>18</u> years of age and under <u>59</u> is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
- 3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


