From the Pastor

There is planning taking place for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress for this summer. If you google the website, you will find that this Congress will be a "pivotal, unifying and transformative moment for the Catholic Church in the United States." It will take place in Indianapolis, starting on July 17th, and it will close on Sunday, the 21st. The website explains what events are planned for each day at the Lucas Oil Stadium.

Plans call for people to travel from southern California, and there will be celebrations along the way. They will be passing through our community the 11th and 12th of July on their way to Indianapolis. There will be something in Effingham on 11 July and here in Teutopolis on 12 July. What these two days will look like is yet to be determined, but there are conversations taking place.

The Spring Clergy Conference is this Wednesday and Thursday, 6 and 7 March, in Springfield. All the pastors in the diocese are required to be at the meeting on Wednesday evening. Mass schedules will not be affected. I am sure there are some Catholic churches in the Bible Belt part of our country, who would love to have the number of people we see at our 6:30 weekday Masses in Lent.

Lenten Regulations

- 1. ABSTINENCE—Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST—Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
- 3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


