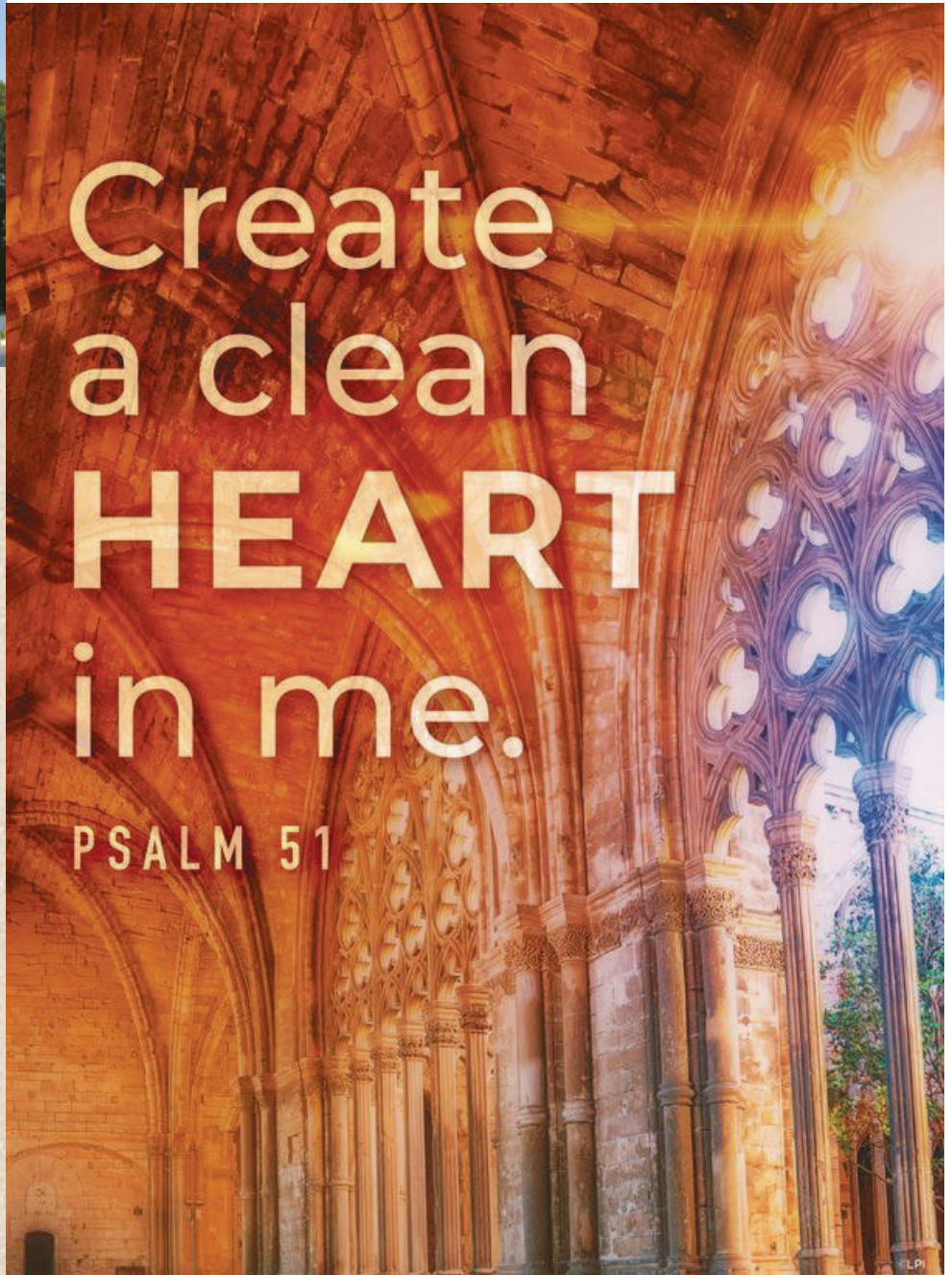

And I am grateful for your generous cooperation with that campaign. I hear good things from parishioners when they are using the Center. The Committee did an excellent job. I will keep you posted on both the Vitality Committee and the work of the Diocesan Centennial Campaign as it applies to our parish.

Two weeks from today is Palm Sunday, believe it or not. I remind you of our opportunity for receiving the sacrament of penance or reconciliation on Thursday, March 21st, at 7:00 p.m., a week before Holy Thursday.
