From the Pastor

Happy Palm Sunday!! Today marks the beginning of the special time of the year for all Christians: Holy Week! Another word for "holy" is "sacred" so we could call this "Sacred Week." That has a way of making the point of what this week is all about.

We have the Sacred Triduum. Lent finishes at the commemoration of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, which marks the beginning of the Triduum: the holy three days. Our liturgies for each day of the Sacred Triduum are filled with meaning.

On Holy Thursday we have the anniversary of both the Eucharist and the sacrament of Holy Orders. The priests of the diocese will gather on Tuesday in Springfield for the Chrism Mass. If you have never been to the Chrism Mass, you might come to this and see how the bishop of the diocese consecrates the oils that will be used in celebrating the sacraments throughout the diocese in the coming year. I will participate in this liturgy and bring back the 3 oils that will be presented with the gifts at our Mass on Holy Thursday. Each priest has the date of his ordination anniversary, but he celebrates on Holy Thursday the anniversary of the sacrament. There is the washing of the feet, and the Blessed Sacrament will be reserved in the altar where the Blessed Mother is remembered. This time for adoration and prayer will finish at 9:30 Thursday evening.

Good Friday marks our remembering the passion of our Lord. There will be the veneration of the cross, and this is followed by the reception of the Eucharist that has been consecrated at the Holy Thursday Mass. There is quiet and silence in the church. The door of the tabernacle is opened, and the sanctuary lamp is extinguished because the Blessed Sacrament is not present – the only time during the whole year!

Holy Saturday marks the center of our faith: the resurrection of Jesus. He has risen. Christ has conquered death. We start outside with the blessing of fire. The candle is lit, and the Light of Christ comes into the dark church, symbolic of the dark world, and the darkness is pierced by the light of Christ.

Alleluia is our song. We haven't had this word in the liturgy all Lent, but now we sing Alleluia joyfully. Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.


