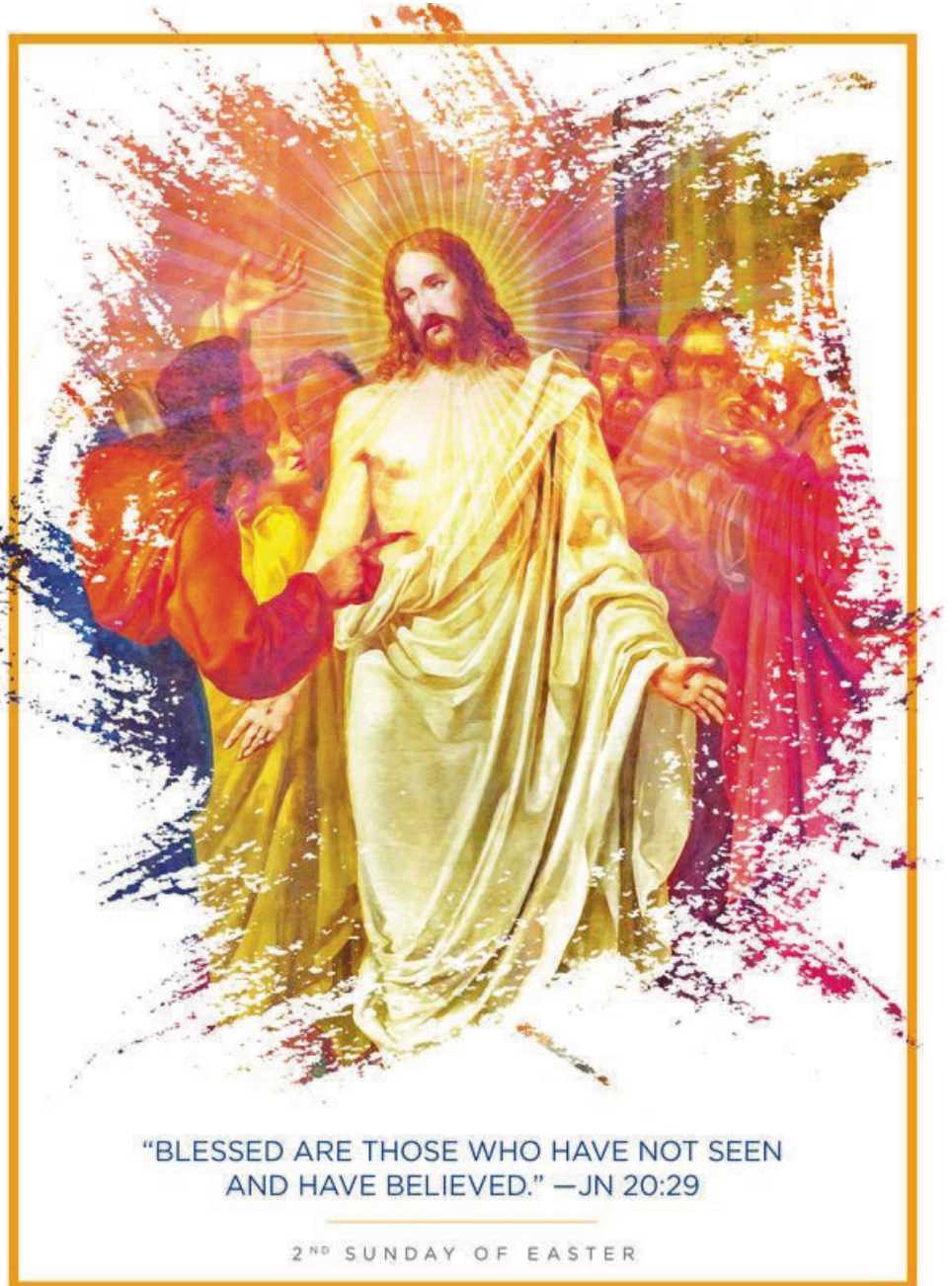

From the Pastor




Alleluia! He is risen! Our Sacred Triduum and Easter Sunday liturgies were certainly community celebrations of St. Francis Parish. Our Art and Environment Committee did it again, as they continue to present an atmosphere for us to praise God. Besides the A and E Committee, our choirs certainly exercised their particular stewardship with song and praise to God. Readers, ushers, eucharistic ministers, acolytes or servers, sacristans – all, who pitched in to help us celebrate our Lord’s passion, death and resurrection – thank you!

Many people are interested in numbers, and our ushers have been counting people at our Masses since the Covid experience. Here are the numbers that are reported. For the Easter Vigil: 297; for 6:30 Easter morning:400; 8:30: 680; and the 10:30: 707. I suspect other parishes also experienced large numbers in terms of attending their Masses for Easter. I appreciate the ushers getting the count for us.

Stewardship is contributing from your financial resources, returning to God a percent of what God has given you. Stewardship is also contributing one’s time and talent besides treasure. Some of you might have heard that Barb Runde wants to slow down from her schedule with the liturgy. She would like to resign from her duties with the Liturgy Committee. We are grateful to her for her stewardship. I’m sure she will be happy to answer any of your questions about the future.

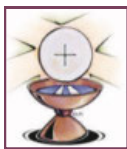

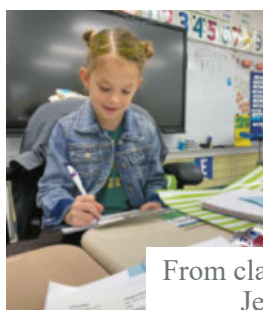
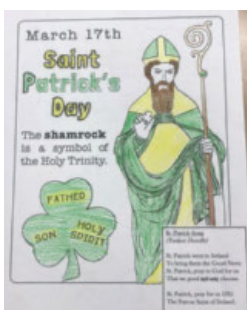
