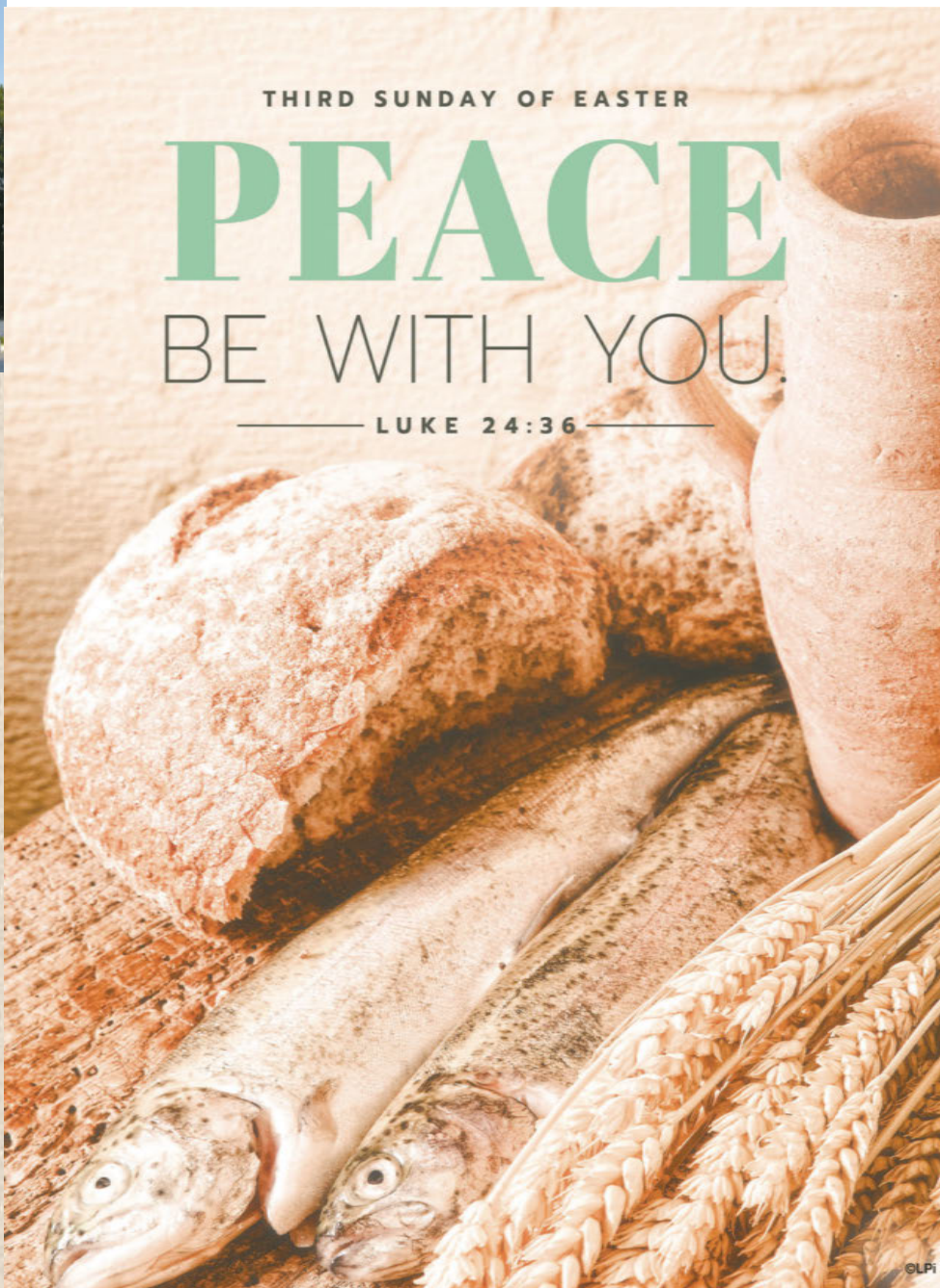

Day of Prayer for Life – Save the Date!



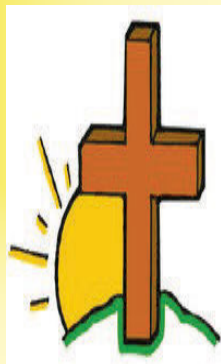

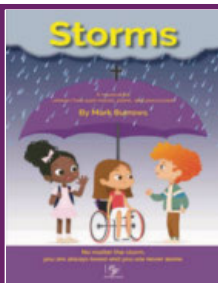
