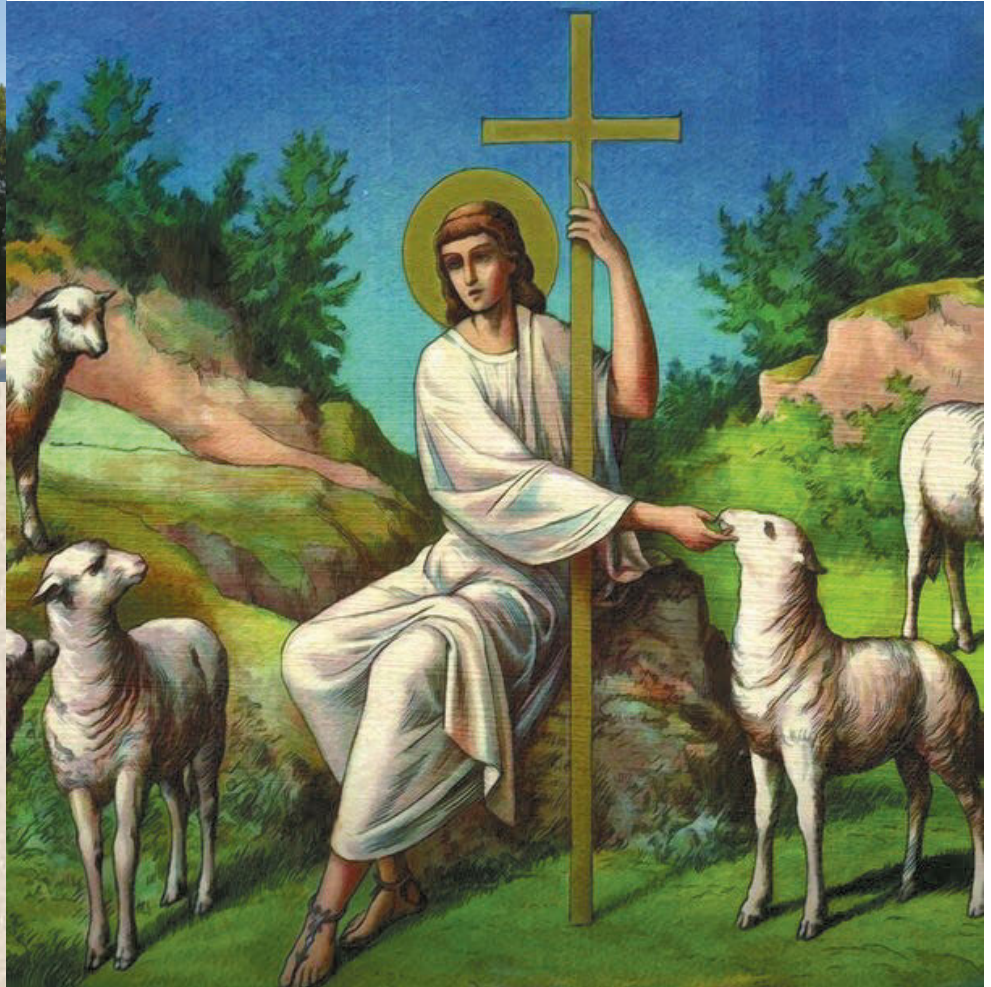

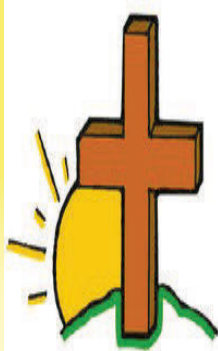
ADULT EDUCATION CLASSES

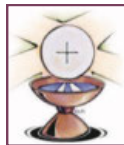

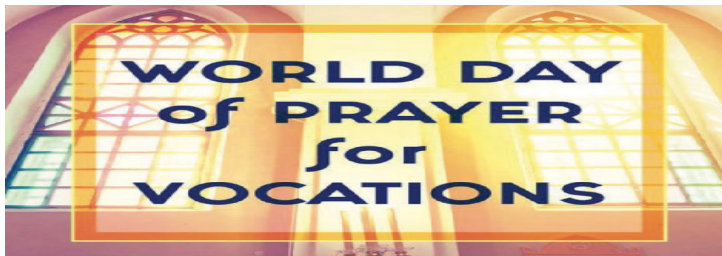


