Recently in the bulletin I mentioned how blessed we are here in Teutopolis, especially in terms of the talents, gifts and skills of our youth. Last week was more evidence of our blessings with the musical “Annie”! Our teenagers worked hard and presented the community a wonderful experience. They had to bring a sense of joy and pride to the members of their families: parents, siblings and grandparents. It made me proud to be a part of this community.

Our Father and Son Breakfast last Sunday was a success. Our ushers do us the service of counting the people in attendance at our weekend Masses. I’m sure the speaker did a good job. It would be good for us to find more occasions for families to come to Mass together: Mothers and Daughters, for example.

On Wednesday this past week, 24 April, we marked the end of the year for our High School Religious Education Program. We had Mass at 7 o’clock. We don’t say “Thank You” often enough to the teachers and catechists who come and share their faith with our children whether the children are in primary grades or secondary grades. Thank you very much. You make an impression on our youth that will last a life time.

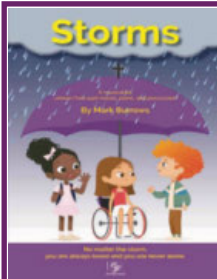
