#### From the Pastor

This Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, is the feast day of St. Peter and St. Paul. If you look on the two front pillars in our church, you will see statues of these two saints.

Peter was called by Jesus to be a fisher of men, and he followed Jesus. He also had a special relationship with Jesus. Along with James and John, Peter witnessed the transfiguration and the agony in the garden of Gethsemani. Jesus relied on Peter to be the leader of the apostles.

Paul had been the most Pharisaic of all the Pharisees and the most legalistic of the Mosaic lawyers. Once he experienced the risen Jesus on the road to Damascus, there was no going back. That experience changed his life. Now he welcomes Gentiles instead of arresting them.

These two men are giants in our history of Christianity and Catholicism. There is a tradition that the seminarians from across the tracks would be ordained priests here in our church on this date. When Fr. Ken Rosswog was ordained a priest, he was a member of a class of 17 new priests.




