From the Pastor

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will arrive in Teutopolis next week on Friday morning at 10:45! Provided the weather is cooperating, we will meet at the KC Tower for a devotional, and then there will be a procession with the Blessed Sacrament, like we have on the feast of Corpus Christi. We will go west on Elm Street, south on Washington Street to Southern Row, and then back east to Wall Street and north to Elm where we will head east to Pearl Street. We will return to the tower for Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament. In the event that we have rain instead of sun, then the prayer will be in our church.

The pilgrimage will stop in seven cities in our diocese. As you saw in last week's bulletin, on Thursday, July 11, from 5:30 to7:30 Sacred Heart is hosting Evening Prayer, Potluck Dinner and witness talks, followed with Eucharistic Adoration from 7:30 to 8:30.

Friday morning, July 12, at 8:30 the Adoration Procession begins at the front entrance of the hospital and proceeds to St. Anthony's Church, where there will be Mass at 9:30. Following Mass the people will come to Teutopolis for a procession with the Eucharist and close with Benediction. I read that 1,000 people had registered for the procession to cross the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco, and on the day of the procession 4,000 people showed up to pray!! This is certainly a national event, and we are honored to participate in whatever way we can. I'm curious to see how many will be in Indianapolis for the days of the convention.

I'm sure some of you have seen Facebook photos from our Catholic Heart Work Camp people in Nashville. Looks like they had a very good time, and many people made memories that will last a lifetime. I always pray for a safe trip because there are plenty of possibilities both getting to the destination and the return but also while they are on site. As we pray our prayers of petition, let us also pray thanksgiving prayers to the Lord that they had a holy, happy, healthy and safe time.
