Then on to Virginia where I'll visit friends and families from the Navy and Marine Corps. Please keep me in your prayers for a safe trip.

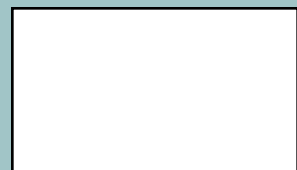
