From the Pastor

We were the last leg in the National Eucharistic Procession in our diocese last Friday. Unfortunately, there was some confusion about whether we would meet in church or at the tower near the KC Hall. It was a matter of "weather permitting." The idea was to meet at the tower for an outdoor procession, but if God sent us showers instead of sun, then we would meet in church. Why not meet in church and march over to the tower? That would be a logistical nightmare with closing off Main Street, Route 40.

Thank you to the Knights of Columbus for their full cooperation - dressing the altar, setting up chairs, bringing the canopy from St. Isidore's Parish, providing the carriers of the canopy and leader of the procession, microphones, and other support roles. Denise Walk, Greg Oseland, Dan Williams picked out the songs and did the leading of songs as we marched. The priests participating were Fr. Seth Brown, Fr. Hyland Smith, Msgr. Dave Hoefler, and Fr. John Titus, who is the dean for the Mattoon Deanery, which used to be the Effingham Deanery. Our own Eric Habing was helpful in transporting materials from the church over to the tower and being the thurifer for the procession. I'm sure I am overlooking someone, and I apologize for that. Our parish treated the "pilgrims" to lunch at the Kountry Kitchen before they continued their journey to Indianapolis via Terre Haute. People in Effingham provided lodging in their homes.

This week I will be leaving my sister and her family in Buffalo and move on to visit friends in Virginia - Fredericksburg, Chesapeake and Virginia Beach. Please pray I have a safe trip.
