Our children returned to school this past week. Some are ready to see their friends again and play with them at recess. Others wish vacation lasted another month or two! In the bulletin this week you will find a brief article that is addressed as “Teenagers...” The message can easily be applied to students of all ages, not only teens. The message is important because it deals with hospitality, which is one of the marks of Stewardship! How do we create an atmosphere where people feel they are welcome? Children can have all kinds of thoughts and ideas about whether people like them or don’t. The message encourages us to be sensitive to the person, who is new and perhaps is withdrawn from people – on the bus, in the cafeteria or whatever. Reach out and welcome the person. Help them feel welcome and at home in your classroom. Parents, please sit down with your children and discuss this important quality of hospitality and help people feel welcome.

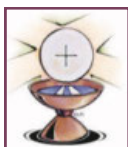

He has a difficult time communicating with us sometimes, because he rarely speaks English in the Congo, and has forgotten some words. He apologizes for not communicating with us through email, as after caring for the boys, he is too tired to sit at the computer. Your donations to help with schooling, food, clothing, etc., continue to be much appreciated!

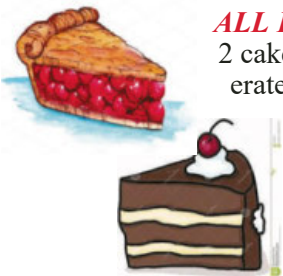

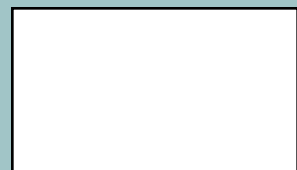
