From the Pastor

This afternoon, Sunday, Sept 15th we will have a guest presentation on the Sacred Stigmata. The actual feast day of the Stigmata is September 17th. What is the sacred Stigmata? Take a close look at our second stained glass window from the front on the east side of the church, the Blessed Virgin side. There you see St. Francis and an angel, a seraph. Webster describes a seraph as a heavenly being surrounding the throne of God, represented as having three pairs of wings, one of the highest orders of angels. In the window you can see in the lower left corner a Franciscan. St. Francis wanted a companion when he went away to the mountain to pray. Can you imagine how surprised this friar was when he saw what was happening. It's my understanding that St. Francis is the first one in the Church to be recognized as having received the sacred stigmata – the wounds that Jesus had on the cross. Since the 13th century there have been nearly 300 cases of people, who have received the wounds. Francis tried to hide the wounds so the people wouldn't see.

This Saturday, Sept 21st, is our parish picnic. We start off with Mass outside at 4:00 p.m. Music will start at 3:00 p.m. Bring a chair. I understand the homily is going to be very, very long!! Be sure to get your golf ball in the game. Sure glad the golf balls are dropped on the grass; would be a real mess bouncing off concrete or black top! People have put a good deal of time in preparing for the picnic, and I hope the Lord provides us with favorable weather and a safe and enjoyable time.

The priests of the diocese have a convocation in Collinsville this week: Monday till Thursday. I'm going to the parish council meeting Tuesday and then will join the priests on Wednesday and return Thursday afternoon.

This weekend we honor all of our Catechists. It is truly a cast of hundreds! There will be a blessing for them at each Mass, and we ask God to reward them for all that they do in order to share their faith with our children – from the smallest child to the senior in high school! Out of the 130 parishes in the diocese, we are the only one that offers PRS, formal religious education every weekday. Our parishioners make that possible, and we are grateful. God bless each of our catechists and their families.

October 4 is the feast day of the patron of our parish. The whole Church celebrates the feast of St. Francis of Assisi on the that day. We will have a special Mass in his honor at 7:30 that evening.




