From the Pastor

Unfortunately it has become something of a cliché to say: "God is good." What happened in our community last Saturday is convincing evidence that God is indeed very good, especially to our parish. People told me they watched the weather on the radar, and they could see the storm heading east – right to our outside Mass and picnic. When the storm got to Effingham and Teutopolis, it made a right turn and went south!! We had darkened skies and a sudden blast of wind just as we were starting Mass. I was fearful that there would be a downpour at any minute. And if the rains continued into the evening and the night, they would have done more than dampened our picnic! The storm turned south, and we had a beautiful evening for Mass and our picnic.

It was an "all hands" adventure, and we are grateful to the Lord and so many people, who pitched in and did their share and more! Jill Ruholl, CCW chair, and Jordan Niebrugge, representing the Holy Name or the Men, are certainly appreciative and grateful to the parishioners, who contributed their time and talent for the success of the picnic. I can't imagine a parish having a picnic for the first time! As with most parishes, the picnic isn't our first rodeo, and people know where this is kept and where to put that and....

The altar always looks beautiful, and celebrating the Eucharist together is the perfect way to begin a picnic celebration.
