

From the Pastor

This morning at the 10:30 Mass we will recognize 46 children from our parish, who were confirmed yesterday (Saturday, October 19) in our cathedral in Springfield. Bishop Thomas John Paprocki confirmed our children. They received the Eucharist for the first time at the same Mass with our bishop. We are glad to have them here today at our parish Mass where they will hopefully receive our Lord in Holy Communion for many years to come. The cathedral is our "Mother Church" in the diocese, so to speak. I'm sure our children will always remember being in the cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.

We thank our Director of Religious Education, Dan Niemerg, his able assistant Camille Neihls, our catechists, who prepared our children, Sue Esker, Sr. Christina, Melissa Ziegler, Jeanine Heuerman, Anita Deters, Tracy Dennis, Cari Buehnerkemper, Susie Niemerg and our Mass Supervisors, who bring our children over to their weekday Masses.

When I was a youngster, I thought the night for trick or treating was right up there with Christmas. Just ring someone's doorbell, a stranger's, and they put candy in your bag!! Wow! The night for trick or treating in Teutopolis is this Friday, Oct. 25th. Please be extra aware of what's going on – if you are walking, or if you are driving. VOTING PRO-LIFE ON THE ILLINOIS BALLOT INITIATIVE - Life, in all its stages is

precious, including embryos. This absolutely includes children born from in vitro fertilization (IVF). However, it is important to recognize the IVF process can be harmful to new human lives.

On the 2024 Illinois general election ballot, there are three advisory referenda for you to review, including a referendum on "in vitro fertilization" that states:

"Should all medically appropriate assisted reproductive treatments, including, but not limited to, in vitro fertilization, be covered by any health insurance plan in Illinois that provides coverage for pregnancy benefits, without limitation on the number of treatments?"

There is much confusion about IVF among Catholics. In the words of *Donum Vitae*: "The connection between *in vitro* fertilization and the voluntary destruction of human embryos occurs too often. This is significant: through these procedures, with apparently contrary purposes, life and death are subjected to the decision of man, who thus sets himself up as the giver of life and death by decree." 
