### **VOTING PRO-LIFE ON THE ILLINOIS**

**BALLOT INITIATIVE** - Life, in all its stages is precious, including embryos. This absolutely includes children born from in vitro fertilization (IVF). However, it is important to recognize the IVF process can be harmful to new human lives.

On the 2024 Illinois general election ballot, there are three advisory referenda for you to review, including a referendum on "in vitro fertilization" that states:

"Should all medically appropriate assisted reproductive treatments, including, but not limited to, in vitro fertilization, be covered by any health insurance plan in Illinois that provides coverage for pregnancy benefits, without limitation on the number of treatments?"

There is much confusion about IVF among Catholics. In the words of *Donum Vitae*: "The connection between *in vitro* fertilization and the voluntary destruction of human embryos occurs too often. This is significant: through these procedures, with apparently contrary purposes, life and death are subjected to the decision of man, who thus sets himself up as the giver of life and death by decree."
