We received a thank you note from the Province of Our Lady of Guadalupe acknowledging the donation of \$1,356.86 that you contributed on Franciscan Day. I still find it difficult to identify with Our Lady of Guadalupe Province when I have been a part of the Sacred Heart Province for over 55 years! Thank you for supporting our Franciscan community.

Busy couple days with the holy day of obligation and 4 Masses on Friday, and then right into the weekend with 4 more Masses. Try to get to the play after Mass this Saturday or on Sunday afternoon!

In terms of All Saints and All Souls days, I have always thought that the Church should have made November 2nd the holy day of obligation instead of having everyone come to Mass on the feast of All Saints on November 1st. I'm sure All Souls would be glad to have so many praying for them at the Masses on November 2nd.

Next Sunday is the birthday of the United States Marine Corps. Wherever Marines are on November 10 they celebrate even if it is only a cupcake! On a large training base with multiple commands Marines celebrate their big day. We will have a service at our cemetery next Sunday afternoon at 2:00 jointly with the members of the American Legion. Some will remember years ago processing to the cemetery from church on a November Sunday afternoon, praying the rosary and then concluding prayers at the cemetery.

Monday, November 11, is Veteran's Day. This year we have the 80th anniversary of D-Day. See the current issue of the Effingham & Teutopolis News Report for excellent information on D-Day, June 6, 1944. We have a national D-Day Memorial, and it is in Bedford, Virginia. It is an interesting stop while on vacation. This location was picked because more men lost their lives during the time of D-Day from Bedford than from any other city in our country – per capita. Bedford's D-Day fatalities were 20 men. Imagine a small town in Virginia suffering the loss of 20 soldiers in one day.

We thank all veterans (living and deceased) for their service to our country.



VOTING PRO-LIFE ON THE ILLINOIS

BALLOT INITIATIVE - Life, in all its stages is precious, including embryos. This absolutely includes children born from in vitro fertilization (IVF). However, it is important to recognize the IVF process can be harmful to new human lives.

On the 2024 Illinois general election ballot, there are three advisory referenda for you to review, including a referendum on "in vitro fertilization" that states:

"Should all medically appropriate assisted reproductive treatments, including, but not limited to, in vitro fertilization, be covered by any health insurance plan in Illinois that provides coverage for pregnancy benefits, without limitation on the number of treatments?"

There is much confusion about IVF among Catholics. In the words of *Donum Vitae*: "The connection between *in vitro* fertilization and the voluntary destruction of human embryos occurs too often. This is significant: through these procedures, with apparently contrary purposes, life and death are subjected to the decision of man, who thus sets himself up as the giver of life and death by decree." 
