#### From the Pastor

The Franciscans and staff of St. Francis Parish wish you and your loved ones a very happy Thanksgiving Day this week. Have an attitude of gratitude is very important. We have Mass at 9 o'clock on Thanksgiving morning. Is there a better way to celebrate Thanksgiving than to come to the Eucharist, which means giving thanks!

Today we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. This feast comes each year at the end of the season of Ordinary Time liturgically. So next Sunday we have the First Sunday of Advent.

Perhaps some of you have seen this written up over Veteran's Day. It's the first time I ever heard of it. There is a cemetery in the Netherlands that has 8,000 Americans buried in it, fatalities of World War II. The cemetery covers 65 acres. This next part I have trouble verifying, but I did find it in one place. For years Dutch families come to the cemetery every Sunday to take care of a grave. They "adopt" a grave, and there are hundreds of people on a waiting list to become caretakers. How many years ago did World War II end – close to 80? These people are grateful for



what the American soldiers accomplished. At this cemetery in the Netherlands, the soldiers' families had a choice: their loved one could be buried at this cemetery, or the soldier's body could be brought back to the United States. I think it could be an interesting study to learn how many American soldiers are buried in Europe because of World War II. I know there are British soldiers buried near Catania, Sicily.
