#### From the Pastor

As you know, we celebrate the second Sunday of Advent today. We continue our journey to the celebration of the Incarnation, when the second person of the Blessed Trinity emptied himself of his divinity and took on our humanity. Christmas. It is fast approaching! I know it isn't fast enough for our children, but it's probably too fast for our mothers, who have a long list of things that need to be accomplished.

In addition to marking the second Sunday of Advent today, we are also celebrating the feast of the Immaculate Conception. Because of the coincidence of having these two feasts on the same day, the obligation to attend Mass for the Holy Day, and the celebration of that day, moves to Monday, the 9<sup>th</sup> of December.

We have our usual schedule of Masses for the holy day of obligation beginning with a Mass at 6:00 a.m. and then Masses at 7:55; 12:10 and the evening Mass will be at 7:00 p.m.

At our recent Parish Council meeting we dealt with the issue of the 4:00 Mass on Christmas Eve. I suspect that every church in the country, that has a Christmas service on Christmas eve, is going to have a large crowd in attendance. At the Council meeting we discussed the possibility of having another Mass earlier in the afternoon to help deal with the crowding, like a Mass at 2:00 p.m. I knew the earliest Mass one can have by way of anticipation on a Saturday is 4:00, but I thought with a holy day it might be different than a Saturday. We learned that 4:00 is the earliest time for Mass anticipating a holy day, so that ruled out that possibility. We also discussed a 6:30 Mass on Christmas morning, but that would likely not decrease the number of people choosing to attend the 4:00 Christmas Eve Mass. The Holy Spirit will guide us.

You might have seen the news coming from Rome. During the Jubilee of Teenagers, April 25 to 27, 2025, the Church will canonize a millennial saint. His name is Blessed Carlo Acutis. He was born in 1991, and he died 2006. The more I read about him, the more I am impressed with how he cooperated with the work of the Holy Spirit in his life. A possible slogan for him could be: Non Io ma Dio. This could be translated: It's not about me; it's about God! His final wish was to be buried in Assisi. Carlo's tomb is housed in the church of Santa Maria Maggiore in Assisi. There will be three saints for people to visit when they come to Assisi: St. Clare, St. Francis and Saint Carlo.


<u>CHWC News</u> - St Francis CHWC is fundraising for their 2025 trip to Kansas City.


