#### From the Pastor

Cast of hundreds! Come to church this afternoon (Sunday) at 4 o'clock for our parish concert that involves people of all ages and musical talents and gifts. Our parishioners have worked hard on this, and I have no doubt we will all enjoy it.

This Wednesday evening at 7 o'clock we will have our parish penance service. It is more of an opportunity for you to receive the sacrament of reconciliation than it is a service or a liturgy. We will have our three priests available for confessions that evening.

Less than two weeks away is Christmas. We have 3 Masses on Christmas Eve: 4:00; 6:00; and 10:00. On Christ-



mas morning we have Mass at 9:00. Our ushers count the number of people participating in our Sunday liturgies. Every parish in the diocese counts their parishioners at the Sunday Masses in the month of October. I understand other dioceses do this also. We ask our ushers to do a count at each Sunday Mass for a couple reasons. One reason is that the number they get is electronically sent to the sacristan so he or she knows how many hosts the priest needs to consecrate. If the number of hosts in the large paten in the rear of church is lower, then the sacristan can add hosts to the paten before it is brought up as part of the offertory gifts. Another reason is this metric can be used for future planning of how many people to expect for a particular Mass. The 4 o'clock Mass on Christmas Eve has the largest number of people than other Masses, and the Picnic Mass in September is second to it. Of the four Masses for Christmas, if you can choose a Mass different than the 4 o'clock on Christmas Eve, you'll have more room when you come to church.

**CHRISTMAS & NEW YEAR MINISTRY SIGN UP** -There are ministry sign up sheets for Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day in the main entrance of church. Also, please check in the sacristy the day of the Holy day to see where you are needed. *Thank you for sharing your time and ministry!*




