From the Pastor

Last Sunday we celebrated the feast of the Holy Family. Do you think there is a family in our parish that couldn't benefit in some way from the graces of this feast of the Holy Family? I know our own Franciscan family, we friars, can improve our "family life." We can renew our respect for each other and tune in and really listen when our brother is speaking, and I'm sure spouses in our families can do the same! There is always room for improvement – in everything.

On January 3rd we celebrated the feast of the Holy Name of Jesus. There is a question to give us pause: do we always use the name of Jesus with respect? I have suggested the following as a method of reminding us how to use the sacred Name of Jesus. Resolve that you will always BOW your head EVERY time you say the name of Jesus! If you are giving instructions or teaching, bow your head. If you are praying and say the sacred name, bow your head. I really don't think you can use the Lord's name disrespectfully if you bow your head when you say it.

Today we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, which means manifestation. The magi were following a star, and they spoke with temple people, key people, who would have information for them. They found the infant Jesus in Bethlehem with Mary and Joseph. They were poor people with poor shepherds tending their flocks. God didn't manifest himself as a prince in a palace. The parents likely had the minimum clothing and material for the baby and themselves. We can ask: how does Jesus manifest himself to us? How do we get to know Jesus? Jesus uses people to show himself to others. Other people help us to know Jesus – parents, spouses, grandparents, our children, brothers and sisters, good friends -every one and any one can be possibly a manifestation of Jesus to us. God can use YOU to manifest his goodness.

CLUB. The club will be open to all students enrolled at Teutopolis Grade School and will operate daily on school days from 3:30-5:30 pm.


It plans to offer an after-school snack, and run activity stations students can rotate through including games, outdoor play, homework/study sessions, and arts and crafts.
