

From the Pastor

We started this past week with a funeral on Monday morning. Gene Runde died in the same house he was born in! Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon him. During his funeral homily I mentioned to the congregation that when I was here in the early 1980's, we had a 6:00 a.m. Mass each morning, and often Gene would attend with his whole family, Lenore and the 5 children. I asked him how he was able to get his children to the Mass, and he wondered what I meant. I told him I would expect a hassle from his 5 teenagers about getting up early like that. He had a simple response: "It's a non-negotiable." I suggest that parents today need more "non-negotiables" in their lives with their teens. Eventually the teen will figure out it doesn't make sense to argue this point; it's not going to change.

I used to be able to attend meetings in Springfield via the internet, but the policy has changed requiring a physical presence so I'm back on the road for the meetings with the College of Consultors and the joint meeting with the Diocesan Finance Council, which happened this Wednesday.

On Thursday was scheduled our meeting with the diocese for the Parish Vitality Study. Will have something to report about this in next week's bulletin.

Our annual Pro Life Breakfast is this Sunday from 7:00 a.m. until noon. There is quite a tradition in our community for this breakfast. Loretta Koester spent hours working on Pro Life. Maybe she even started the annual breakfast. The money raised from the breakfast certainly goes to a good and worthy cause. Please support the breakfast.

In two weeks, on Sunday, February 2, our local Knights of Columbus will sponsor the Newman Breakfast, again, from 0700 to noon. There are 80 Newman Centers just in Illinois. Our college age parishioners need to keep in touch with the church and to grow in their faith.


