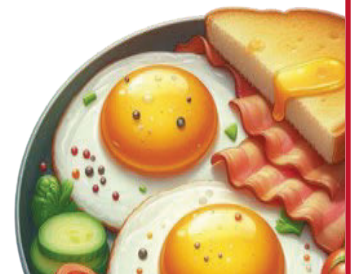
Over 80 Newman Centers throughout the state of Illinois offer college students a chance to gather and practice their faith. Proceeds go to the Newman Fund.
