

From the Pastor

One of the requirements for couples getting married at St. Francis Parish is that they participate in a Pre Cana weekend. We offer this opportunity once a year, and it is this Sunday. So it's not a weekend, but it's an entire day, which is what other parishes offer. Please keep our engaged couples in your prayers as they prepare to give themselves unconditionally to their partner in holy matrimony.

This Sunday is the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Some parishes have the custom of blessing candles on this day and having a procession.

February 3rd is the feast of St. Blasé. Traditionally people would get their throats blessed on his feast. At our Masses this weekend, the priest will incorporate the blessing of St. Blasé with the final blessing. The blessing is: "Through the intercession of St. Blasé, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

I think it's a good thing that the parish didn't take a vote on whether or not to leave our Christmas decorations up until Ash Wednesday! 
