#### From the Pastor

We offer our congratulations to 65 of our second graders, who received the sacrament of reconciliation or confession for the first time this Saturday morning. Some came at 8:30, and others came at 10:00. This is not a sacrament of initiation. The sacraments of initiation are baptism, confirmation and holy Eucharist. These children will be confirmed by Bishop Paprocki and receive the Eucharist for the first time in August. They will then be fully initiated in the Church.

This Sunday evening we will welcome the 3 new members to the parish council and say farewell to the 3 members who have served the last 3 years. Retiring members are Shannon Hinkle, Rhonda Meyer and Dennis Runde, while the new members are Lisa Siemer, Gabe Rauch and Johnny Meinhart. We thank the retiring members for their work and service to the parish while serving on the council. I hope each of them would feel like she or he has learned more about the parish during their ministry on the council. In the Navy we called such meetings a "Hail and Farewell."

Mark your calendar for this Thursday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, for the Parish Penance Service. As many of you know, there really isn't a "service" but it is more of an opportunity to receive the sacrament of penance or reconciliation. Your three priests, assigned to St. Francis Parish, will be in church and available to minister to you the sacrament of reconciliation.

For some time now we have offered the sacrament on Saturday afternoons from three to four o'clock, and on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:15 to 6:45. There will NOT be confessions this Tuesday evening from 6:15 to 6:45. See the next paragraph!

This Tuesday and Wednesday (March 18 and 19) Fr. Dat, Fr. Juan and I will be at a Priests' meeting in Collinsville. Pastors are REQUIRED to attend the annual meeting, and from what I've seen not many, if any, miss the meeting. We are thankful to Fr. Dennis for presiding at both the 6:30 and the 8:00 Masses on Wednesday, the feast of St. Joseph.

Next Sunday, March 23, at the 10:30 Mass Jeremy Tomes will enter the Catholic Church. Many years ago he was baptized in the First Christian Church in Paris, IL and he has been coming to Mass with his wife, Sarah, for many years. This year he has been part of our OCIA program, the old RCIA, and now he is ready to make the step into Catholicism.

Would have been great for both Teutopolis and St. Anthony to be among the top four schools in the state for basket-ball this year, but it wasn't meant to be. Our teams have made four consecutive trips to Carbondale for post season basket-ball, and we can be proud of those achievements. We are grateful to all of our young men and women who have played in various sports. #### **Lenten Regulations**

- 1. ABSTINENCE—Everyone <u>14</u> years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST—Everyone 18 years of age and under 60 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


