

From the Pastor

We have new leadership with our parish council. At the last meeting, which was the last meeting for our outgoing members (Shannon Hinkle, Rhonda Meyer and Dennis Runde) the newly constituted parish council elected their leadership, and the president of the parish council is Dr. Charles Runde while Dan Blankenship will serve as the vice president and Monica Kremer will be the secretary for the council. Again, the members of the parish are grateful to Shannon, Rhonda and Dennis for their work with the council for the past three years.

I mentioned in last week's bulletin that the Masses for Saturday and Sunday, 22 and 23 March, saw a decline in each Mass of the weekend compared with the usual participation from the parish. I am glad to report that the attendance at our Masses this past weekend was back to what we are used to. For the four weekend Masses usually, we have between 1,350 and 1,475 parishioners. The weekend of 22/23 we had 1,200! Last weekend we had 1,375 people.

At the last council meeting I shared with the members that I let the new province of the Franciscans know I intended to retire on July 1, 2025. I have been asked to 'stay on' until after the Chapter next year, which would mean some time in August of 2026. None of us is getting any younger, are we?

CRS Rice Bowl-Catholic Relief Services provides resources to bring Lenten spirituality to life for families, parishes and school communities. We can do our part by answering Jesus' invitation to share bread for life with our sisters and brothers, so all may live with dignity. 
