From the Pastor

The parishioners of St. Francis congratulate and wish God's blessings on all the fathers in our parish, and we include grandfathers, godfathers and people, who sometimes take the places of our fathers. It is easy for us to take people for granted, especially the members of our families. May God bless our dads, those living and those deceased.

This Wednesday is our Day of Prayer for Respect for Human Life. This is a day of Adoration beginning with Mass at 8 o'clock in the morning, adoration all day, Benediction at 7 o'clock in the evening, and we conclude the day with the Eucharist with Fr. Michal Rosa presiding. Different groups of people are scheduled throughout the day.

On Saturday morning people from across the diocese will gather at our Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield for Mass with Bishop Thomas John Paprocki to honor the Woman of Distinction in each parish. Members of our Council of Catholic Women have identified Lisa Siemer to be our parish's Woman of Distinction. Lisa would be the first to say that there are other women in the parish who deserve this honor, and that's true, but who is to say one is more deserving than the other? I'm sure it was a difficult decision to make.

I thank the members of the parish, who have sent cards of greetings and congratulations as I celebrate 50 years of priesthood. The Dio family, whom many of you welcomed at the 4:30 Mass last Saturday, were very impressed by the beauty of our church and how friendly people were with them. It was something of a whirlwind trip for them as they left Virginia Beach Thursday night and then left St. Louis on Sunday night to return home. With their 7 children in the van, it seems traveling at night works better for the children sleeping. The van is a 15-passenger van! It was really great to visit with them again. I had their wedding in Norfolk, VA 25 years ago.

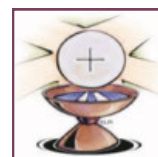

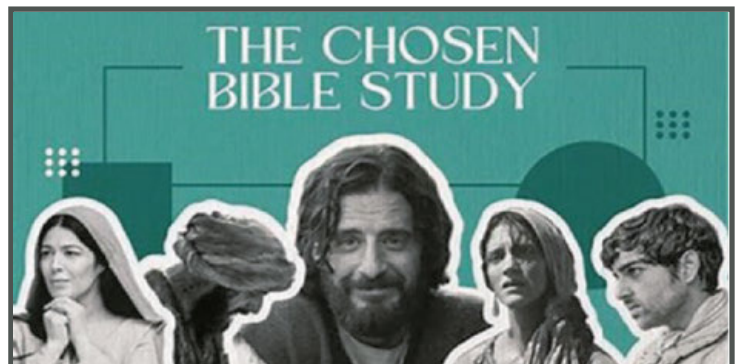
