



Dear Parishioners and School Families,

December 31: 2021 Donation Deadline

December 31 is the last day donors can receive a 75% tax credit on their 2021 Tax Credit Scholarship gift. We hope you will consider making a donation to Empower Illinois and help make it possible for a student in need to receive a scholarship and attend St. Patrick School. To allow Empower Illinois ample time for processing, gifts via check should be mailed by December 20. Individual and corporate donors can make contributions to Empower Illinois who then will fund scholarships. In turn, donors are eligible to receive a 75% state tax credit. Be sure to choose St. Patrick School when you complete the donation process for designation of your funds. Families will begin applying for scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year in January. Thirteen students were recipients of scholarships for the 2021-2022 school year. Thank you.


