

Parishioners are asked to take a half-hour time period. You may sign up through the weekly Flocknote email or on the sign-up sheet on the information desk in the gathering space.

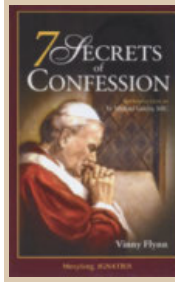

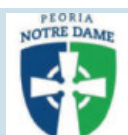
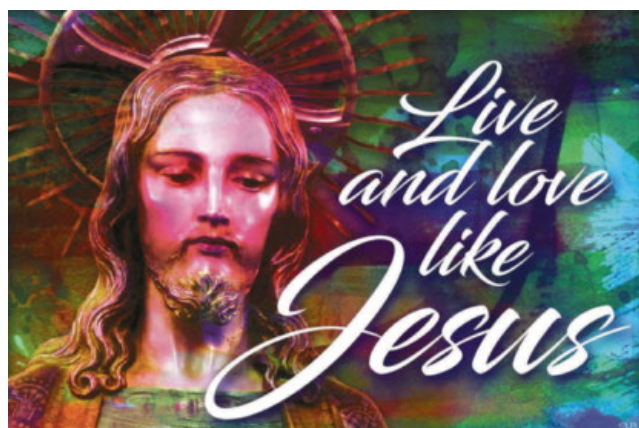
