

Holy Communion will be distributed after Sunday 9:30 AM Mass, at the front doors of the church, under the canopy 10 minutes after Mass, until all have received.





Easter Basket 2022


COMING SOON!! Easter Basket 2022 will once again take the place of the food drive and we will be collecting donations for



Knights of Columbus Fish Fry




The Morton Knights of Columbus will hold their 2022 Lenten Fish Frys on: March 25; April 1, 8, 15

Parishioners are asked to take a half-hour time period. You may sign up through the weekly Flocknote email or on the sign-up sheet on the information desk in the gathering space.




