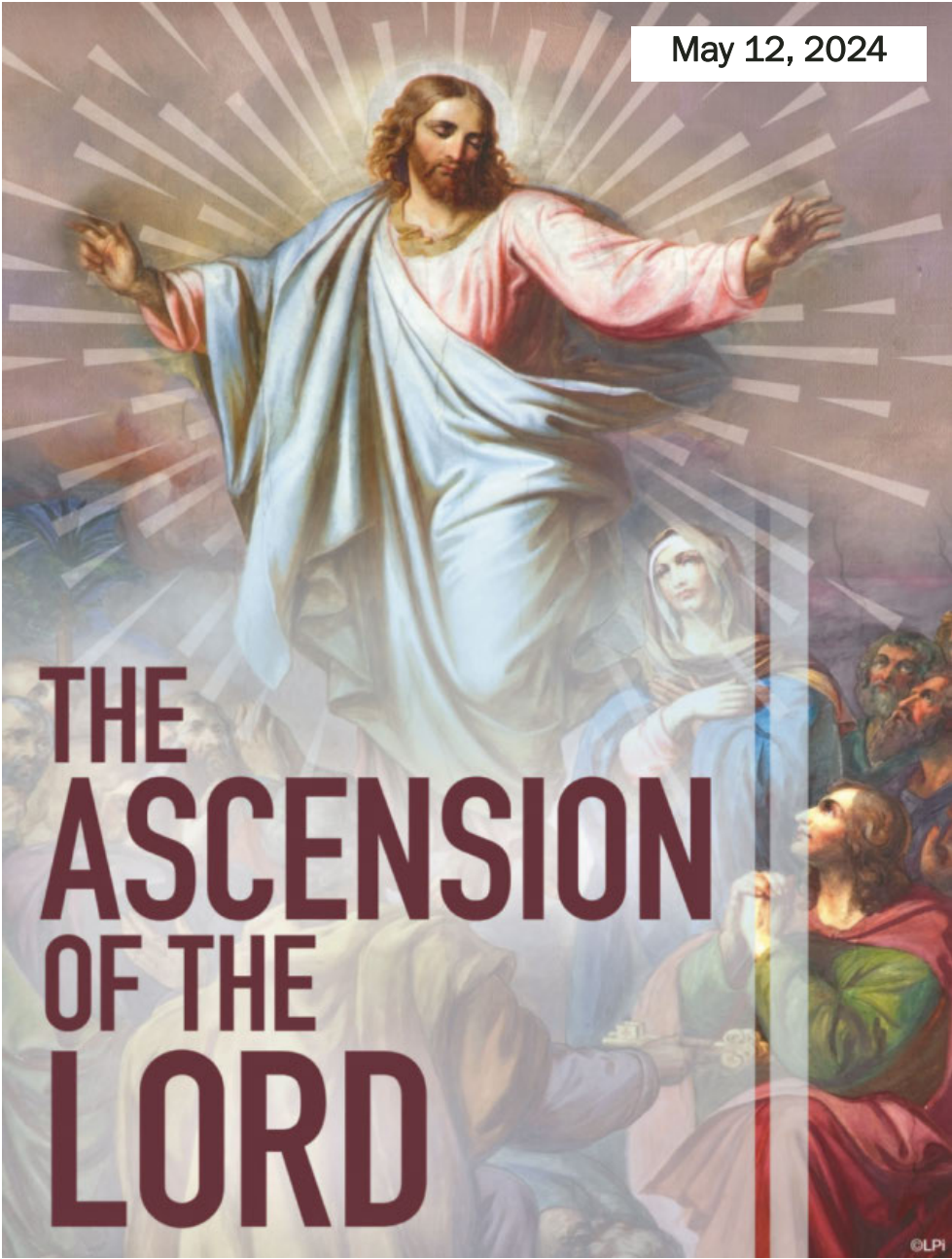

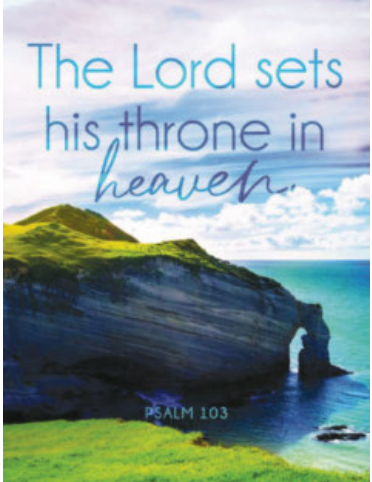

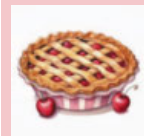

The liturgical color for this feast is **RED**. As a way for you to connect to this feast liturgically, you are encouraged to wear something **RED** to Mass next weekend.

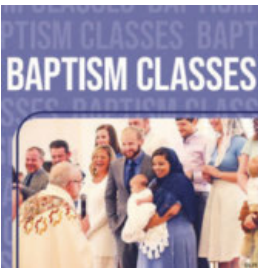


GUYS & PIES

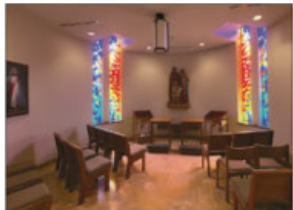
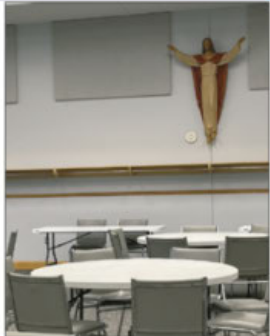

- ◊ Artist murals, new statues, and an altar for the Adoration Chapel



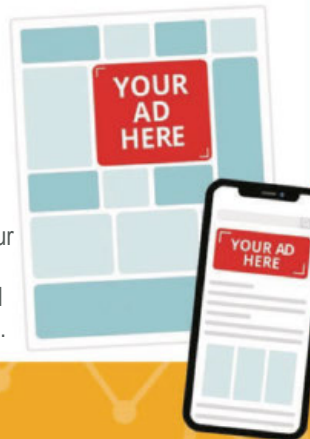
