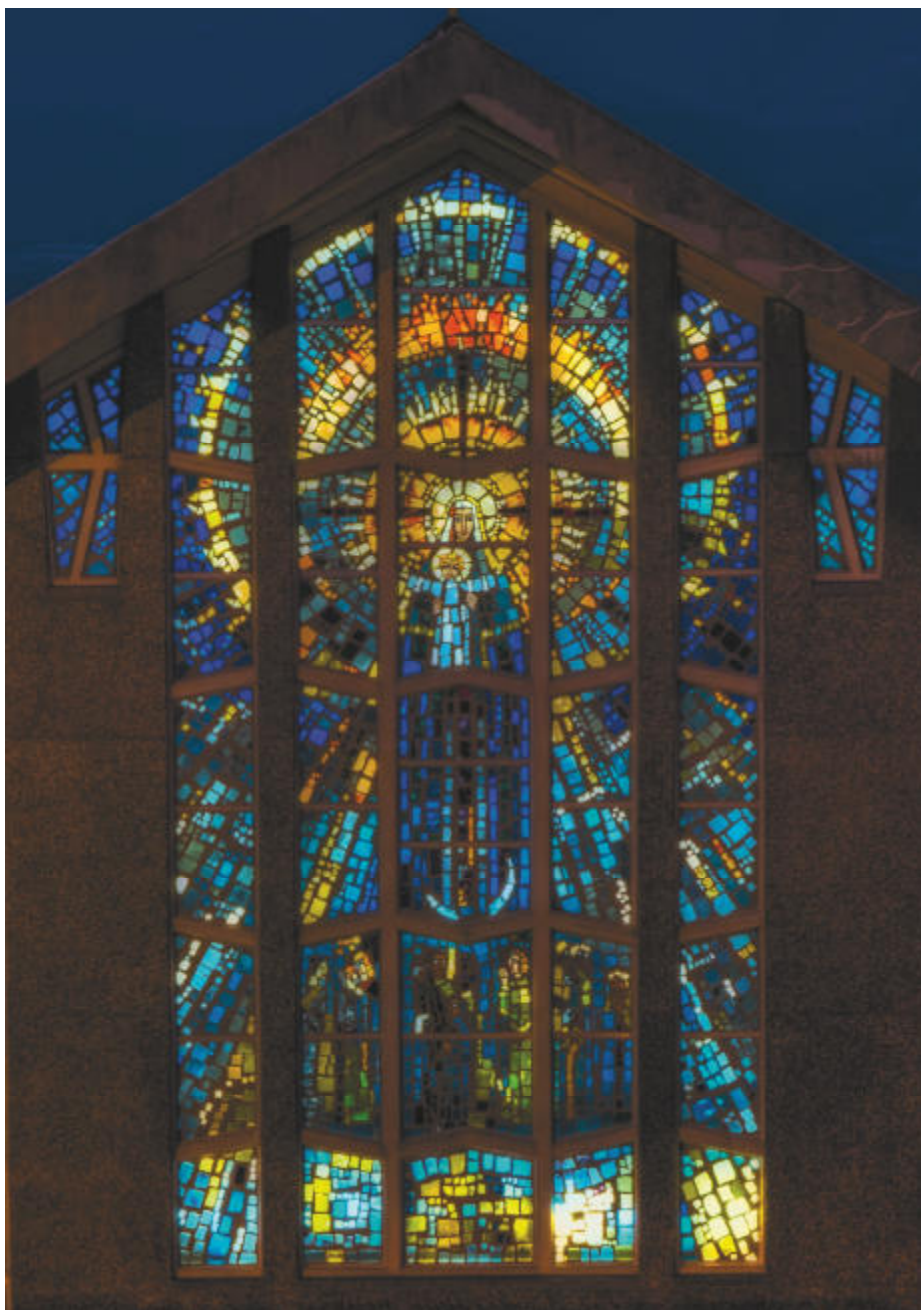

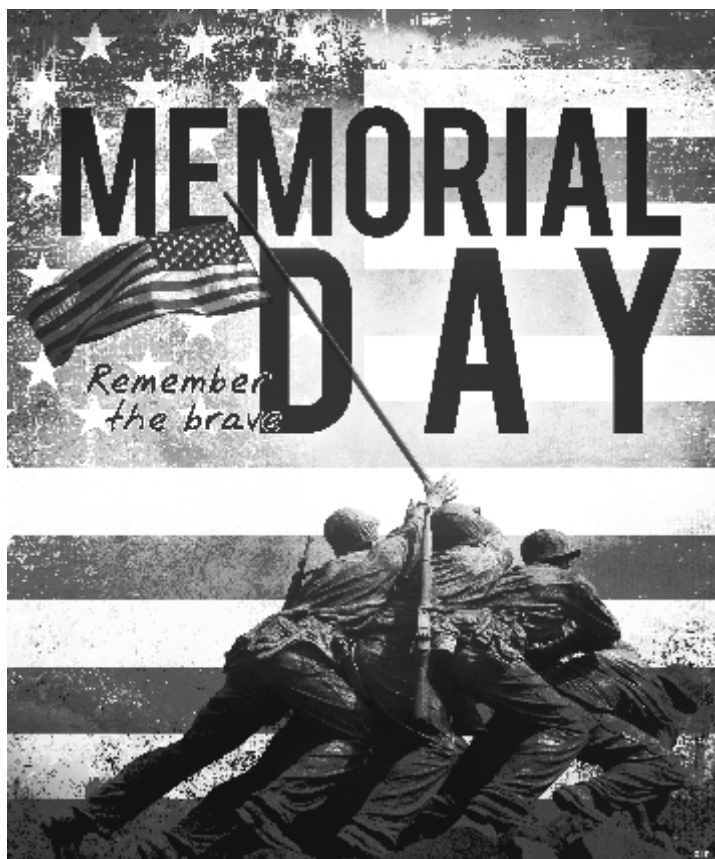
## Today's Gospel

2. He gave them a commission. He sent them out to make all the world his disciples. The fact remains that the commission of Jesus is to win all men and women for himself.
3. He promised them a presence. It must have been a staggering thing for eleven humble men from Galilee to be sent forth to the conquest of the world. Even as they heard it, their hearts must have failed them. No sooner was the command given, than the promised followed. They were sent out, as are we, on the greatest task in history, with them there was the greatest presence in the world.

### *Simply Said - for Automated Contributions*

St. Rita Parish has an online contribution system called Simply Said. This system allows parishioners to automate recurring and / or one-time contributions to St. Rita. Once you set up an account, you can have your contribution taken from a checking or savings account at a predetermined date and amount. *You control the amount, frequency, and start and stop dates.* You can sign up for the Simply Said system at any time.

There are two ways to sign up: an online set-up or a paper enrollment form. Parishioners who do not have internet access can call the Parish Office for a form to fill out. Those with internet access are able to enter everything themselves by accessing the link to Simply Said from the St. Rita website.
