PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION

Holy Week is again upon us with this weekend's celebration of Palm Sunday. From the mighty king who triumphantly entered Jerusalem to the abandoned savior who had only a handful of people gathered at His cross, we see a great transformation of the people from Palm Sunday to the days of our Lord's passion and cross. For many, it was very difficult to understand Jesus' message of glorification through death. We, however, understand it very well, and we remember all the fruits that our Lord's death and resurrection brought about in this holiest of weeks. I pray that you will be able to join us for our Masses and liturgies – either in person, or via live stream. This is an important journey to make, and it brings even more meaning when we celebrate the resurrection, having walked with our Lord through this entire week. Make this a prayerful, holy week, friends.

We continue to make progress on the *Go Make Disciples* campaign. We're looking forward to engaging the parish as a whole with the message of evangelization. We have a great evangelical tool that is now part of the parish's ministry to all parishioners at St. Bernard. *Formed* is a ministry of the Augustine Institute. It is best described as the "Netflix of Catholic Programming". There are many excellent opportunities to learn more about the faith. We'll be utilizing the *Formed* platform as we continue with the *Go Make Disciples* program. Sign up is easy – go to <https://signup.formed.org> You'll need to search for our parish. Type St. Bernard in the parish line, and our parish will be the third one down on the list. Once you select our parish, you'll be asked to enter in your email address. That's it! You'll be able to enjoy many hours of excellent Catholic catechetical programming. For those who use Roku, Amazon Fire TV, Apple TV or other streaming gateways, there is an app you can download to enjoy *Formed* programming right on your television! It's a wonderful additional to our catechetical programming here at the parish, and I hope that many will take advantage of all that *Formed* has to offer.

The redesign of our parish web site is complete. We're in the process of updating content and putting the final touches on it. It is our hope to roll it out next week. Please stay tuned!

May we encounter many graces in this coming Holy Week as we enter the fullness of this time with our Lord and accompany Him faithfully, so that we may rejoice with Him in His resurrection.
