
Dear Friends.

The time is upon us! This weekend will be our last weekend in the church for the foreseeable future. Beginning next weekend, the church will move over to the gymnasium. We will remain there for approximately one year. Our final Mass in the church will be on the Solemnity of our Lady's Assumption – Tuesday, August 15th at 12 noon. We have a plethora of skilled tradespeople circling the church and will come in short succession to carry out their tasks before we prepare for the liturgical painting. Many of you have asked me if there is an image or two I can share of the church as it will look after all the changes. We're working toward that goal, and as soon as the liturgical painting is finalized, we'll be able to share some images with you.

I made a basic map of the gymnasium which will help orient you to its setup. Note that there are **two entrances to the gymnasium**: (1) Through the main doors of the parish center. The main doors have steps or a

ramp to help you down to the gym level. (2) The west entry doors are at the same level as the gym, so there are no steps to navigate. However, there is a 90-degree turn from the outer entry doors to the inner doors that provide entry and exit access. Both of these options will be available to you on the weekends. During the weekdays, however, only the main doors will be open for daily Masses.

I elected to place chairs in the gym for the main seating area. After we're finished using them, they will serve as chairs for priest concelebrants at large diocesan Masses and liturgies. chairs are comfortable, sturdy and have arms, which will help those who need a bit of extra assistance getting up and down. For the kneeling portions of holy Mass, the assembly may choose to kneel on the gym floor or remain standing. If you wish to kneel and would like to bring a kneeling pad with you from home, you are most welcome to do so. An area of special needs seating will be established near the main entrance for those with



mobility issues to minimize the amount of walking needed.

Please note that on Wednesday, August 16th, Thursday, August 17th and Friday, August 18th, daily Masses will be celebrated at 7:45am at the Schoenstatt Shrine, located at 5901 Cottage Grove Road in Madison. Live streaming of these Masses will most likely not be available. Weekday Masses and the 10:00am Sunday Mass will continue to be live streamed from the gymnasium for those who join us online.

It will take a bit of time for us to become oriented to the new space, but we'll get there. As work progresses in the church, I will provide pictures and regular updates in the display cases outside the main entrance of the gymnasium. It will be exciting to watch the transformation of our campus!

To celebrate our first weekend in the gym on August 18th and 19th, we will commemorate the solemnity of our parish patron, St. Bernard of Clairvaux. The choir will be present with us for this Mass. After the morning Masses on Sunday, please join us for refreshments in the St. Veronica Community Room (formerly "Room 1").

We extend our prayers to the family of **John Speropulos**, a member of our parish who died recently. May the Lord's mercy speed him home to his eternal reward. We also unite in prayer with the parishioners of St. Peter Parish as they mourn the loss of one of their long-time pastors, **Fr. Roger Nilles**. Fr. Nilles will be buried on Monday of this coming week. May the Lord grant him the blessed vision of His glory in thanksgiving for his many years of service and ministry to the people of the Diocese of Madison.
