
Remember your loved ones with a Mass. Contact the parish office at 618-397-2287. Dear Friends in Christ,

I am inviting the faithful in our area to gather for Mass on the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, May 31, at 6:00pm at St. Clare Church in O'Fallon. The Visitation celebrates the meeting of the Blessed Mother with her cousin St. Elizabeth as recorded in the Gospel of Luke (1:39-56). This beautiful encounter of two women, each expecting a child, moves us to marvel with them at the gracious goodness of God who is the Author of all life.

BLESSED SACRAMENT ST. VINCENT de PAUL CELEBRATES 75 YEARS!

Blessed Sacrament St. Vincent de Paul was established in 1948. Throughout the years our mission the poor, the forgotten and less fortunate among us.

Currently, eighteen parishioners are active Vincentians who provide assistance to our needy neighbors during the year.

Our services include:

- Staffing a Help Line phone system to field calls from the needy.
- Sponsoring the Annual Giving Tree to brighten the Christmas season.
- Maintaining a Food Pantry to provide canned goods and dry foods to families in need of groceries.
- Providing paper goods and household cleaning supplies.
- Assisting SVDP Drop In Center with food, snacks, water and drinks throughout the year.
- Providing rent and utility assistance to families. Over the next few months watch for a more detailed description of these programs in the hope that our parish family will find it in the goodness of their hearts to JOIN us in responding to the CALL OF THE POOR.

The **BIGGEST NEED** is cash or checks to buy meat for the pantry. Or follow the steps below!




- 1. Grab a bag with the list of items needed attached. These are located in the back of church by the food barrel.
